


Midwest Referee Quick Start

Read This First

This quick start guide is not intended to take the place of the manual. It's intended to give you an overview of everything you need to do to get started working as a referee and to get paid. Quick Start Steps

- Read the paragraph above first
- Attend a grassroots clinic (learning.ussoccer.com/referee)
- Join Midwest Referee assigning group on assignr.com using: midwestreferee.com/join
- Go to the Financials menu item in assignr.com. Fill out bank information and W9 so that you can be paid.
- If you're under 16, get a work permit specific to Midwest Referee
